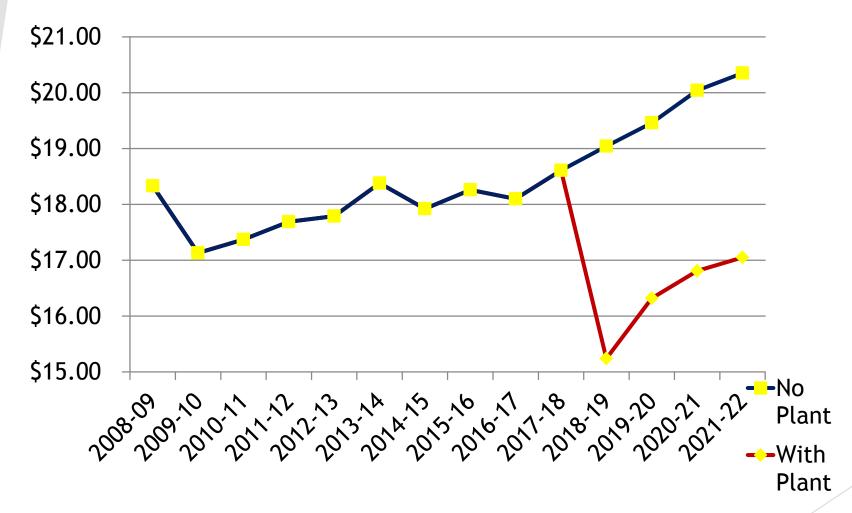

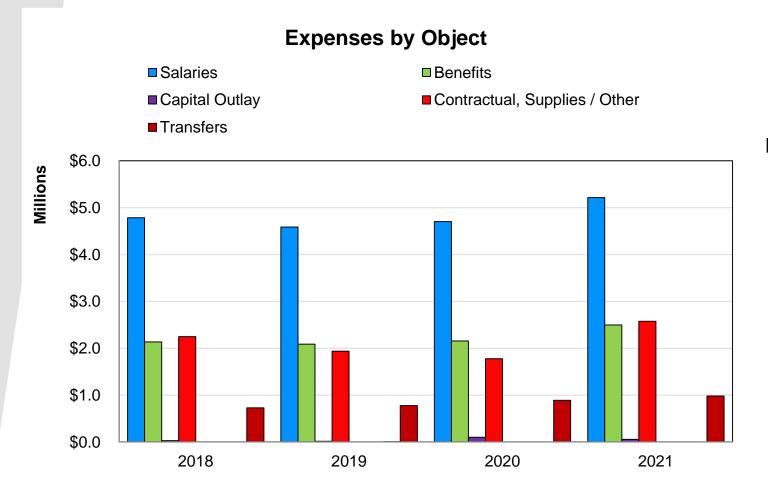

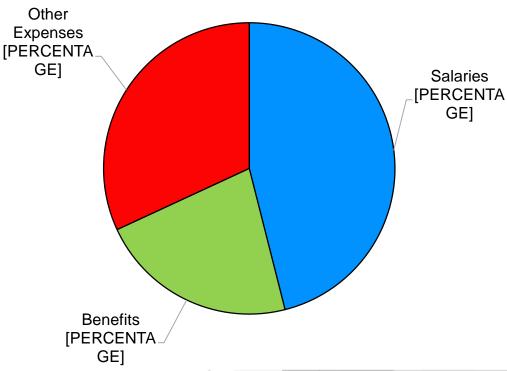
Tax levy increase of 4.49% from total 2020-2021 school tax levy (Tax Cap of 6.5%)

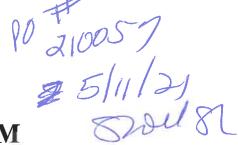

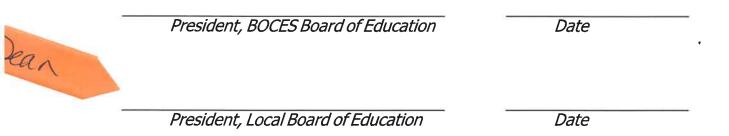
