
DERUYTER CSD - NEW YORK STATE REPORT CARD [2021 - 22]

The New York State Report Card is an important part of the Board of Regents' effort to create educational equity and raise learning outcomes for all students. 

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2018 TOTAL COHORT REGENTS IN SCIENCE




