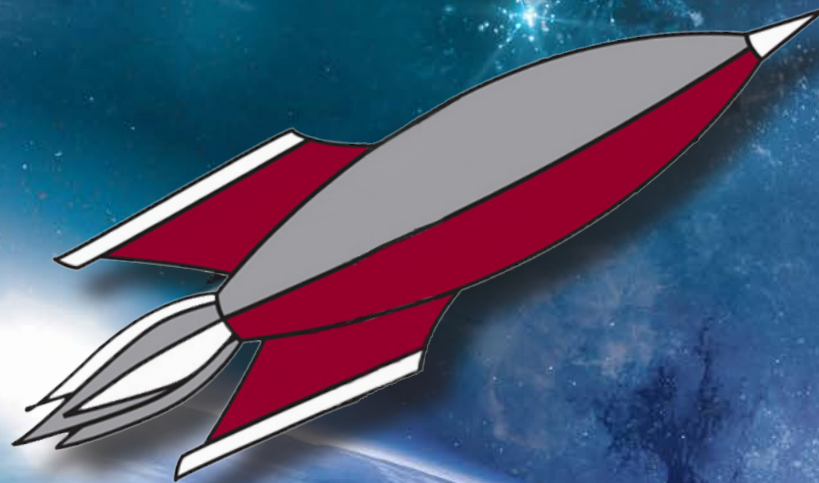

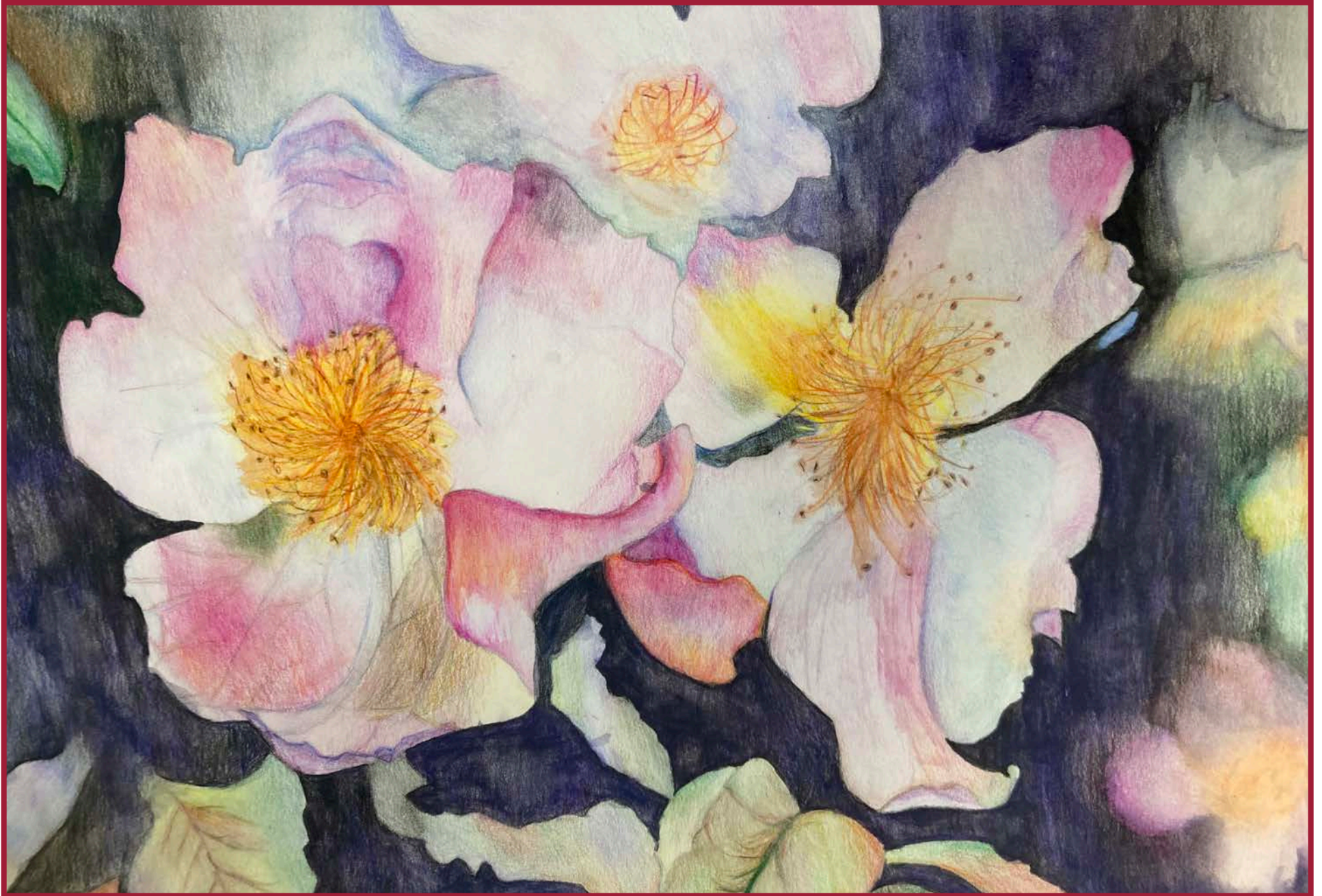

Medical Concerns PK-12

- Step 1: Contact the Nurse. *If the problem is not resolved....*
- Step 2: Contact the Building Principal

Special Education Concerns/Special Needs, PK-12

- Step 1: Special Education Teacher. *If not resolved....*
- Step 2: Special Education Director

Response to Intervention (RTI) and Academic Intervention Services (AIS) concerns

- Step 1: AIS Teacher (math, reading, etc.). *If not resolved....*
- Step 2: School Psychologist
- Step 3: Building Principal

Curriculum (Class or course) concerns

- Step 1: Teacher and/or guidance counselor.
If not resolved....
- Step 2: Building Principal

School Difficulties (Grades, behavior, etc. PK-12)

- Step 1: Classroom teacher or counselor. *If not resolved....*
- Step 2: Building Principal

Transportation Concerns (Pick up, routes, etc.)

- Step 1: Transportation supervisor. *If not resolved....*
- Step 2: Superintendent

Other transportation concerns (Behavior on bus, etc.)

- Step 1: Bus Driver. *If not resolved....*
- Step 2: Building Principal
