



## **Tips for Remote Learning Success**

- ***A remote school day is still a school day.*** Set school hours and encourage routine. Students are expected to attend synchronous classes and complete asynchronous assignments on remote days.
- Participate in class.
- Set up a dedicated learning space. The space should be quiet to reduce distractions. Ensure your child uses this space to access synchronous lessons as well as to complete asynchronous assignments.
- Stay organized.
- Reinforce good work habits and foster attention to the task. Snacks, toys, video games, pets, siblings, and other distractions should be kept away from the dedicated work space whenever possible during school time.
- Schedule break times into your child's remote learning day similar to the breaks they would be getting at school.
- Post a daily schedule for your child to follow. Children of all ages thrive on routine and predictability.
- Be a remote attendance HERO- here (logged in), everyday, ready to learn, on time.
- Keep your cool if you start to fall behind. Reach out to your teacher or principal for help.
- Stay in contact with your child's teacher.
